OVERVIEW

The CITA-Professional Mentoring Intensive is a focused, hands-on two-day workshop designed to take experienced architects from "I think I'm ready" to "I know I'm ready." Working directly with a CITA-Distinguished mentor, each participant receives personalized guidance on their documentation package, a calibrated skills assessment against Iasa's Five Pillars of Architecture, and live mock board rehearsals that simulate the full review experience.

This workshop also serves architects targeting the CITA-Distinguished level, with dedicated sessions on what distinguishes D-level practice and contribution from P-level demonstration.

LEARNING OUTCOME

By the end of the two days, each participant will have:

- An updated documentation package with mentor-reviewed revisions.
- A scored skills gap analysis across all Five Pillars of Architecture.
- A personal preparation plan with target board date and milestone activities.
- Experience presenting to and responding under questioning from a board-level panel.
- A clear understanding of what CITA-P board members look for and what disqualifies candidates.
- Visibility into CITA-Distinguished expectations, including the contribution and influence dimensions that set D-level practice apart

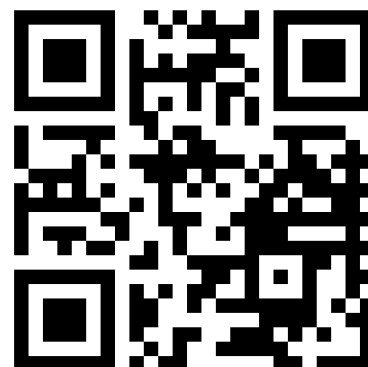
